

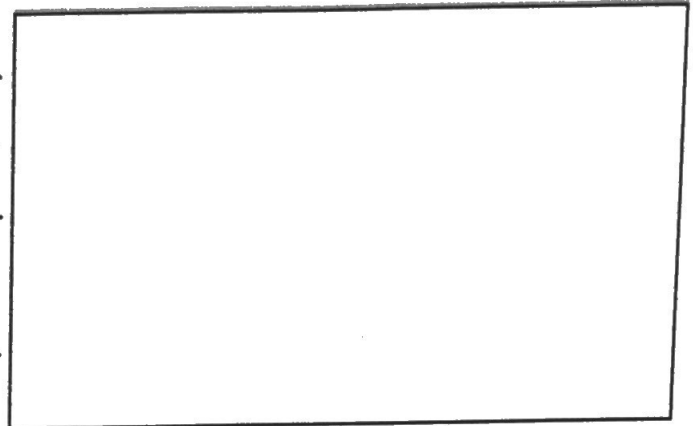

In this chapter, a new character is introduced: Fred Stephens. List three things you learn about him and draw a picture of what he looks like.

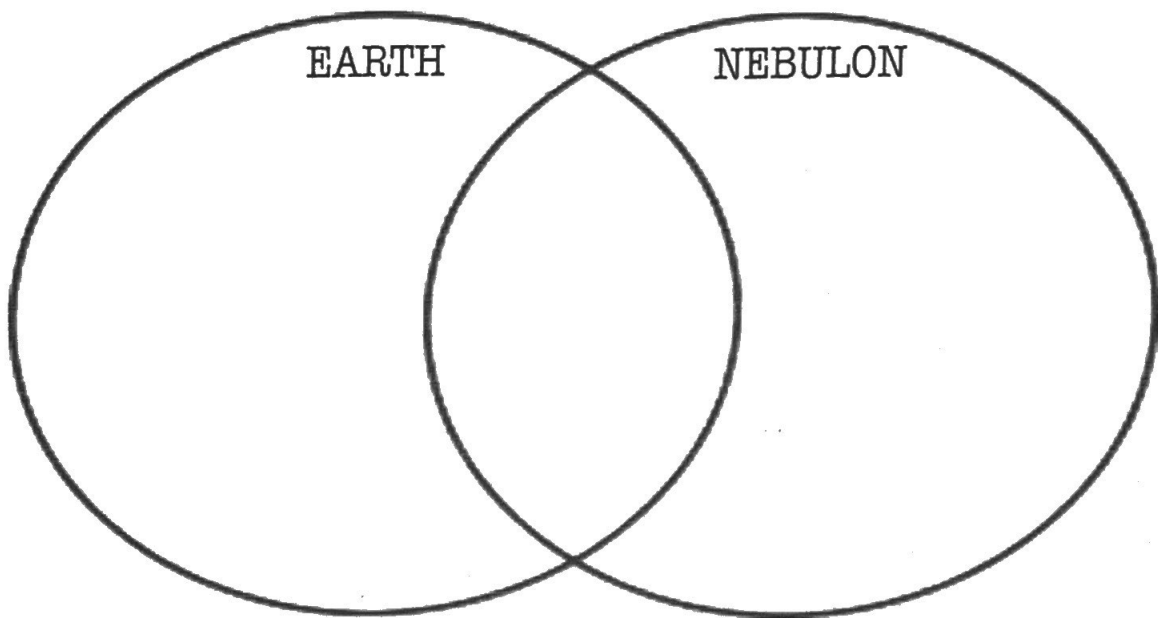

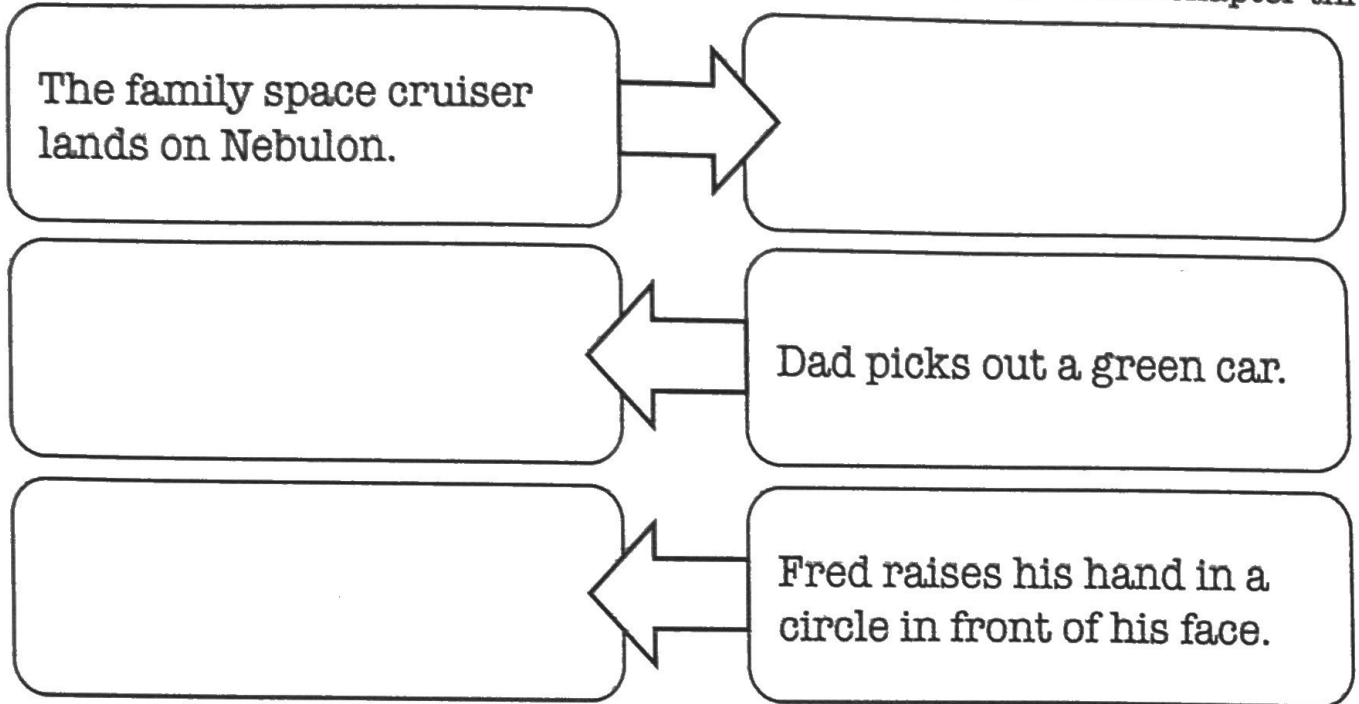
